<p>Can you find some objects (up to 9) and split them into 2 piles. Add them together, how many do you have? Can you record your number sentence i.e. <math>2+4=6</math>?</p>	<p>Can you design a bridge?</p> <p>How will it stand on its own?</p> <p>Can you balance a small toy on it?</p> <p>Take a picture or draw a picture of your design.</p>	<p>Can you draw your own troll and label it using adjectives to describe his features? E.g. sharp teeth, big nose.</p> <p>Can you write a sentence about it?</p>	<p>How is it the same or different to celebrations you've experienced such as Christmas?</p>
<p>Select some objects and subtract an amount. Count how many are left and record your number sentence.</p>	<p>Go on a spring walk.</p> <p>What can you see?</p> <p>Draw a spring picture showing what you found.</p>	<p>Act out the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff with family members.</p> <p>You can be as many characters as you wish.</p>	<p>As it is the year of the snake, can you make your own snake?</p> <p>You could use paint, recycling materials etc.</p>
<p>Can you make a repeating pattern using objects?            For example: spoon, fork, spoon, fork.</p> <p>Car, train, train, car, train, train.</p>	<p>Create your own dinosaur.</p> <p>Will it have wings? A long neck? Sharp teeth?</p> <p>Write some words/ sentences to describe your dinosaur.</p>	<p>Pretend you are a dinosaur explorer.</p> <p>Can you make a map for us to follow to find the dinosaurs?</p> <p>You could include trees, volcanoes, rivers, caves etc.</p>	<p>Can you design a troll?</p> <p>Maybe you could paint it, colour it in or use recycling materials to make a model?</p>
